After learning about this, not only does An-Chi not report Chih-Heng to the police, but she still helps Chih-Heng when the police catch her in a lie. Chih-Heng, on the other hand, continues to insist that no one has gotten hurt by her videos even in the face of the glum An-Chi. That is, until she realizes that An-Chi is also one of the victims of those videos. Chih-Heng meets up with an older student who used to date Yi-Wen and learns the truth. The older student was looking for Yi-Wen when she found out that Yi-Wen was now seeing Ming-Chuan. Hence, she confronted Ming-Chuan on the rooftop, where Ming-Chuan fell to her death during the conflict.

When he gets home, he becomes aware of something strange happening to the surroundings and to his family -- in the mansion the TV set broken for long, no magazines, newspapers or books around, and even no records on each person's bankbook. Other than that, all his family have no expression in the face and act so oddly. "Why are you all sitting here? Are you expecting me to come home?" Zhixiang asks. Each one's reply comes the same saying, "Nothing. I'm just killing time watching the tube "Zhixiang can't help wondering why his family are getting so weird, and before long he is feeling himself living in an unreal world, his memories seemingly filled with lies and illusions. Are his family being manipulated as human puppets? How can people live like that? Yesheng Ling, the army platoon commander who had solved the cases in The ursed Checkpost and The Ensanguined Rifle, got wounded in The Bloodred Love Letter. Synopsis

Over the years, he began to see the barrenness of these dreams and realize how naïve he was, having witnessed the brutality of the civil wars in Yugoslavia. In the 1990s, the journalist visited war-torn Afghanistan to interview the guerrilla commander Ahmad Shah Massoud, the "Lion of Panjshir". During that period, Mohammed Najibullah Ahmadzai became the President of Afghanistan with the support of the Soviet Union, who saw him as a puppet leader of the country. Compelled by a strong sense of nationalism, Ahmad Shah devoted himself to opposing Najibullah's regime and had multiple successes in dealing great damage to Soviet troops in guerilla combat. His leadership in these endeavors earned him the title of "Lion of Panjshir" from fellow Afghans. After the departure of the Soviet Union from Afghanistan and the rise of the Taliban, Ahmad Shah once again retreated to Panjshir, which he defended with all his might. At an international conference, Ahmad Shah warned the world about the Taliban threat. Just five months after his warning, the September 11 attacks happened, sending out shockwaves around the world, just two days after Ahmad Shah himself got assassinated. After the death of Ahmad Shah, the journalist returned to Panjshir hurriedly, only to find that the hero was no more, and not even his memory remained.

However, the event is actually a maneuver of the mayor in his bid to become the Premier of Taiwan. In view of the agenda behind the event, the Longshan Temple refused to loan out their Buddha statues to the city government. The temple even issued The Bangka Declaration of Independence as a warning to the city government, which serves to remind the authorities that they should always prioritize the needs of the people in its governance of Taipei City. Seeing that the event organization has come to a deadlock, the Department of Information and Tourism has no choice but to engage the help of Wang Hui, a professional baseball player long past his prime, in the negotiations with the temple personnel. Can the former star catcher tackle all the challenges thrown his way? Chen Hao-Wei, a lovelorn soldier serving his military service, and Tai Jeng-Chao, a taxi driver haunted by apparitions, also become embroiled in this "battle of religions ". Will the unremarkable lives of the three protagonists take a dramatic turn as a result of this conflict? Many familiar scenes of Taipei City are featured in this book, which utilizes multiple perspectives to present the Taiwanese temple culture and observations of the Taiwanese society in all their authenticity.

In the cultural schema of the ancient Formosan peoples, dreams are linked to both divination and clairvoyance. Dreams are our subconscious, and they sometimes evoke the collective subconscious hailing back to the lived experience of our ancestors, creating a palimpsest between these memories and current social conditions, resulting in the evolution of legends. What did not make sense were attributed to ancestral memories, while the parts that did are reflections of the society at a given time. The story of Formosa is a tapestry of elements from Western, Eastern, and Austronesian cultures, comprising fantastical beings or powers that have existed since ancient times, such as the Grandaunt Tigress, the Negritos, moo-sin-a demons, sprites, doppelgängers, and many others. With her sensitive and perceptive writing, Yi Fen Chen's thought-provoking story takes the reader on an exploration of life.

The Office of the Governor-General of Taiwan Art Exhibition Cape No. 7, a tribute to the The Everlasting Bloom exhibition, reminds one about their passion and strength in the pursuit of dreams!

During a visit to the "HOPE! Post-War Japan Art Exhibition" organized by the Maeda group, arts and culture journalist Lin Yueh-Hsueh chances upon a portrait of a woman. The woman in a cheongsam is the same one who has been appearing repeatedly in Yueh-Hsueh's dreams. In the quest to learn the identity of the mysterious woman, Yueh-Hsueh meets Maeda Hikaru, the curator of the exhibition and CEO of the Maeda Group. The two of them trace the painting back to the Dadaocheng of 1943, when Japanese painter Kotani Ryo engaged the gorgeous Taiwanese geisha Yuetan to be his model for his painting, which he planned to showcase at the Office of the Governor-General of Taiwan Art Exhibition.

It is the season when phoenix flowers go into full bloom, their petals blazing like wildfire. Can Yuetan escape the ill-fated destiny of so many Taiwanese geishas? How did Kotani Ryo end up at the Muryoji Temple in Wakayama Prefecture? Meanwhile, Yueh-Hsueh and Hikaru's time together has brought them closer to each other. How should they reconcile the practical challenges brought about by the differences in their backgrounds? Will this journey reignite their courage to stay true to themselves and pursue their dreams?

In this project supported by the National Culture and Arts Foundation, a young writer from Penghu pens a novel of his hometown based on historical documents, oral history as told to him by the elderly, and stories of his own family. This book provides an important piece of the puzzle that has, until now, been missing from the restoration of transitional justice for the victims of the February 28 Incident in Penghu. The writer anchors the tale in his family history and presents the past and present lives of the island of Penghu.

Past historical records have all stated that the Penghu people "did not participate in the February 28th Incident." Not only that, the KMT government even built the Xiying Paradise Monument as a sign of appreciation to the people of Penghu for not putting up any resistance during the incident. The monument has always been viewed as evidence of the compliance of the Penghu people, but in reality, what it represents is an ultimate case of historical revisionism.

The writer, having glimpsed an alternate version of history that departs from the "official" version disseminated by those in power from the story of his great uncle Chao Wen-Pang, the oral history of elderly residents on Gaillardia Island (Penghu), and limited historical documents, decided to put pen to paper to produce a written record of these stories, so that the struggles of his relatives and friends will not be forgotten in the march of time.

This book shares a little-known perspective of Taiwan's history by presenting the lived reality of the common people against a backdrop of turbulence caused by political instability.
